Learning objectives

This course will give you a summary of modern economics research that examines gender disparities in a variety of fields, seeks to identify their causes, and assesses the efficacy of various mitigation strategies by looking from COVID-19 perspectives. We will discuss a variety of important subjects, such as the differences between men and women in terms of income and work, gender and education, risk aversion, competitiveness, and other characteristics, and gender and public policy before and after COVID-19 in the EU zone.

Prerequisites

It is advised to have taken at least one prior microeconomics and one prior econometrics course.

Content

Weeks 2-3: Gendered Implications of Healthcare Access and Utilization During the COVID-19 Pandemic in EU zone

Weeks 4-5: Economic Consequences of COVID-19: Exploring Gender Disparities in Unemployment, Income Loss, and Financial Resilience in EU zone

Weeks 6-7: Remote Learning and Gender Equity: Bridging the Educational Gap During and After the Pandemic in EU zone

Weeks 8–9: Gendered Effects of Remote Work: Challenges and Opportunities for Achieving Equality Post-COVID-19 in EU zone

Week 10: Policy Responses to COVID-19 and Gender Equality: Lessons Learned and Future Directions

Week 11: The Obstacles and Opportunities for Women in Pandemic Leadership and Decision-Making

Week 12-14: Presentations

Methods of Instruction

Both lectures and smaller-group seminars are scheduled.

Evaluation

Ten weeks of lectures make up the course schedule. Three homework assignments (50% of the final grade) and the final test (50% of the final grade) will be used to evaluate the pupils. Students who fail the course will also have the opportunity to retake the exam.
